Freja eID Release Notes

These Release Notes describe all the changes made to the Freja eID systems from the previous release. They include:

- changes in the Freja eID mobile application from version 2.2.0 to 2.3.0 on iOS and from 2.1.0 to 2.2.0 on Android

Summary

• Swedish driving licence added to OCR scanning – In addition to being able to scan their passport during the process of upgrading to Freja eID+, users will now be able to scan their Swedish driver's licence as well.

Swedish driving licence added to OCR scanning


The purpose of OCR document scanning is to ease and simplify the step in the upgrade to Freja eID+ process where users are asked to enter information from their chosen ID document. In addition to the Swedish passport, which is already supported, users will now be able to scan their Swedish driving licence as well.

Once the document is scanned, the information required is automatically entered into the application thus removing the hassle of slowly entering long numbers and lowering the margin of error.

Procedure

The procedure for scanning the driving licence is identical to scanning the Swedish passport. Once users have chosen the Swedish driving licence as their ID document, they will be prompted to scan it – it is necessary for the application to catch the so-called machine-readable zone on the document.

The application will then recognise and fill in all the required information automatically. In the next screen, users are prompted to check whether the information is correct. If it is, the rest of the upgrade to Freja eID+ flow resumes as usual.



As before, users may opt out of this feature. If so, or if scanning fails due to poor lightning or image quality, users will still be able to enter the necessary information manually. Manual entry remains obligatory for documents that are still not supported for OCR scanning e.g. the Swedish Tax Agency ID Card. Prior to entering the information, users need to take a photo of the chosen ID document.
