These Release Notes describe all the changes made to the Freja eID systems from the previous release. They include:

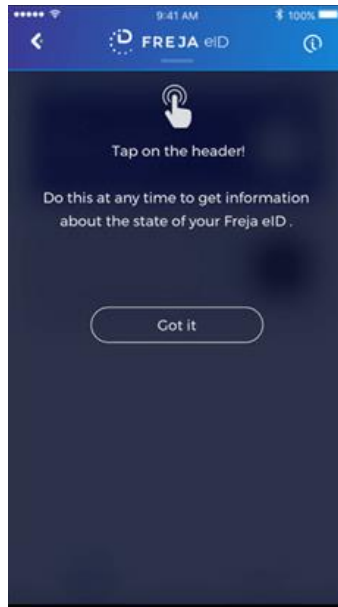
- Changes from version 3.2.0 to 3.3.0 on iOS, and
- Changes from version 3.3.0 to 3.4.0 on Android.

SUMMARY

- **COACH MARKS (ANDROID)** – In order to improve usability and user experience, new Freja eID users on Android devices will have coach marks to guide and show them how to navigate the mobile application.
- **UPDATED LOGIN ACTIONS**– Freja eID users will now have a clearer and more user-friendly login action.

COACH MARKS (ANDROID)

Upon completing the registration to Freja eID, people will be greeted by a coach mark. Its purpose is to teach new users to navigate the Freja eID UI. More precisely, it will draw people's attention to the drop-down header component that contains vital information about the state of the user's Freja eID account.

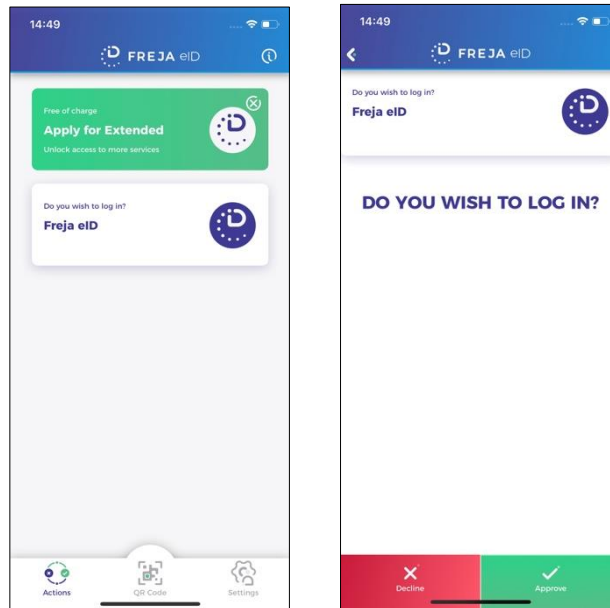


This coach mark will only be shown to the user the first time they complete their registration. By tapping the 'Got it' button the coach mark is dismissed, and the user is taken to the main screen.

UPDATED LOGIN ACTIONS

We have updated the look and feel of login actions to be clearer and more user friendly. They are now more reminiscent of existing sign actions in the Freja eID mobile app.

Once the user initiates a login, the action will open immediately for the user to approve/decline. The name of the service that the users is trying to access has been made clearer, with the action they are trying to accomplish being additionally emphasised as well.
