FREJA RELEASE NOTES

These Release Notes describe all the changes made to Freja systems from the previous release. They include:

- Updates to the Freja mobile application from version 13.8.0 to 14.0.0 on both Android and iOS.

Summary

- EU/EEA ID CARD SUPPORT IN FREJA

It is now possible to register in Freja using an ID card from most EU/EEA countries.

EU/EEA ID Card Support in Freja

It will now be possible for users to complete the identity verification step in Freja using ID cards from most EU/EEA countries. This comes as an alternative to biometric passports that are already supported.

The procedure will be completely identical to using the Swedish national ID card already supported in Freja.

Users from EU/EEA countries, however, will not be granted Freja+ directly as is the case for Swedish national ID card holders, and will need to complete the procedure for Freja+ with a verified coordination number.

Countries not included

Citizens of **Denmark** and **Iceland** will still have the biometric passport as their only option.

National ID cards from Iceland cannot be accepted yet, and Denmark does not issue national ID cards.
